

Illinois - Business Strength in Numbers

Exporting is a significant portion of Illinois' Economy

- Since 2002, Illinois exports have grown \$24 billion
- Illinois exports totaled over \$50 billion in 2010, a 20.3% increase over 2009, ranking as the #1 state for exports in the Midwest and as the 6th largest exporting state in the US
- Direct exports accounted for 7.7% of the Gross State Product (GSP) in 2010
- Illinois ranks #1 between the Coasts for exports and # 1 in the Midwest
- 632,800 Illinois jobs were supported by exports in 2010



Foreign Direct Investment

- Illinois ranks #1 in the Midwest as a destination for foreign investment
- Illinois has attracted 1,596 foreign firms with 5,744 locations
- These firms employ over 288,700 Illinois residents

Illinois and NAFTA

- Illinois has realized significant benefits from NAFTA related trade
- Canada and Mexico are Illinois' two largest trading partners importing approximately 38% of Illinois' total exports
- Illinois exports totaled more than \$19.3 billion to NAFTA country partners in 2010
