The consultation program provides no-cost assistance to identify safety and health hazards, correct the hazards that are identified, and to develop and implement safety and health programs.

"Arlington Dental Group has demonstrated a sincere commitment to providing a safe workplace for their employees and that translates to a healthful setting for their patients," said DCEO Director Jack Lavin. "By publicly recognizing participants in SHARP, our hope is that other employers will follow their example in providing the safest working environment they can for their employees."

SHARP was established to publicly recognize the safety and health achievements of exemplary employers.
