

# Manufacturing in Illinois

Illinois is one of the nation's manufacturing leaders, boasting annual value added productivity by manufacturing of more than \$94 billion in 2001. About two-thirds of the state's manufacturers are located in the Governor's Northeastern Economic Development region, with more than 40 percent of Illinois' approximately 17,000 manufacturing plants located in Cook County.

Food manufacturing, with an annual value added by manufacturing of \$14.0 billion, is the leading industry in the state. Chemicals is second with value added of \$12.7 billion. Non-electrical machinery, particularly construction, farming, and metalworking machinery, is third with an annual value added of \$11.6 billion.

The next largest manufacturing industries in Illinois are fabricated metal products (\$10.3 billion), computer and electronic products (\$7.1 billion), plastics and rubber products (\$6.6 billion), and transportation equipment (\$5.9 billion).

During 2003, 35 Illinois-headquartered Fortune 500 companies made 7.2 percent of the sales attributed to the entire 500 companies on the list. The \$95 billion gross output of the 17,000 manufacturers operating in Illinois represents 24.2 percent of the Illinois Gross State Product.
